SB1 – Atkins (in Assembly Appropriations Committee)

- Directs Ocean Protection Council to create State and Regional SLR Support Collaborative
- Directs OPC to support local assessment and planning to mitigate SLR
- Upon allocation by legislature in annual budget act, provides \$100M for Coast and SF Bayshore community plans
- Expands CA EPA's Environmental Justice small grant program to \$2M/yr.
- Requires \$500k/yr. to NGO's in underserved communities for SLR
- Links funding to a future state Resilience Bond measure.

AB 897 – Mullin (in Senate EQ Committee)

- Directs Office of Planning and Research to provide a framework and guidelines for regional adaptation plans (ALL hazards/impacts)
- Does not provide funding
- Requires OPR by July 2022 to:
 - ✓ Set boundaries and guidelines for regional climate networks to produce plans.
 - ✓ Define the content of the Adaptation plans
- By Jan 2023, OPR will advise the legislature on funding and technical assistance options to support regional climate networks.

Budget

Governor's "Climate Resilience" (May) Budget is about \$1.3 Billion for both Mitigation and Adaptation efforts.

- Only \$25M (2%) is specifically allocated for local government adaptation planning.
- Legislature's "counter-offer" is \$3.7 Billion + \$400 Million for state and local transportation adaptation grants
- The Local Government Commission & 80 others have requested a budget that allocates approximately \$1.5 B for specific local government and community adaptation planning.

Budget Process

- By July 1, the Governor and legislature will agree on a budget number (amount only)
- Between July 1 and early September, the Governor and Legislative leaders will negotiate specific programs and funding levels

Funding for Bay Wetlands Restoration (Good News!)

Federal:

o <u>House</u> bill (passed) provides \$125 Million over 5 yrs. for SF Bay restoration/protection studies and projects)

- o <u>Senate</u> bill (if passed) will provide \$250M over 5 yrs.
- o If Senate bill passes, Conference Comm will negotiate

State:

o Gov's budget provides \$200 M statewide for wetlands restoration.

o Legislature's "counter" allocates \$200 M just for S.F. Bay.
